## SUICIDE SURGE



Doctors in Northern California are reporting more deaths due to suicide than coronavirus during the pandemic.

"The numbers are unprecedented," said

Dr. Michael deBoisblanc of John Muir Medical Center in Walnut Creek, California. DeBoisblanc said he's seen a "year's worth of suicides" in just the last four weeks alone. Kacey Hansen, a trauma center nurse, told the *National Examiner*: "What I have seen recently, I have never seen before. I have never seen so much intentional injury."

Suicide has been an increasingly significant problem across the country as the coronavirus outbreak caused stay-at-home orders that led to unemployment and stress.

## Abortion Activists Hack Pro-Life Zoom Event, Bomb It With Gay Porn and Nazi Imagery

The United States objected to the inclusion of the term and rejected the notion of an international right to abortion.

Phil Harvey, the CEO of Adam & Eve, who made millions selling erotic materials has donated \$9 million to Marie Stopes International, an organization that commits abortion in 37 countries around the world.

Lindsay Fay, a mission team manager for The Culture Project, said this highlights the obvious connection between pornography and abortion. "[In] the pornography industry and the abortion industry, [they promote] ... empowerment for women, but it is actually a false form of empowerment. There really is an enslavement to feeling the pressure to end the pregnancy or end a human life," she said.

### Planned Parenthood affiliates improperly applied for, received \$80 million in coronavirus stimulus funds, feds say

Thirty-seven Planned Parenthood affiliates applied for and received a total of \$80 million in loans from the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP).

The Small Business Administration is contacting Planned Parenthood to explain that affiliates of larger organizations with more than 500 employees are not eligible for the Paycheck Protection Program. The Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PFFA) alone has had more than 600 employees. The SBA warned "severe penalties" were possible, beyond mandatory repayment.


### International Assault On Religious Liberty

Dozens of international left-wing organizations recently signed a statement lecturing the U.S. State Department's Commission on Unalienable Rights. Leading the pack are the Center for Reproductive Rights, Human Rights Watch, and the International Women's Health Coalition.

The letter addressed to the Commission on Unalienable Rights says, "we urge the Commission to reject the prioritization of freedom of religion as a cloak to permit violations of the human rights of women, girls, and lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) people."

The fact is that religious liberty has long been recognized throughout the world as a foundational right. Therefore, it should never be put on the same moral or legal plane with reproductive or sexual rights. To do so is to devalue religious liberty. ### Bishops Respond to England's New 'Opt Out' Organ Donation System

A new law treating all adults in England as potential organ donors unless they opt out "potentially undermines the concept of donation as a gift," the country's bishops have said. A statement by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales May 20 noted that the Church has consistently encouraged organ donation.

"However, a system of presumed consent risks taking away the right of the individual to exercise this decision," it said.

The National Health Service (NHS), the U.K.'s publicly funded healthcare system, hopes the new law will produce an additional 700 transplants a year by 2023. It added that those who tested positive for COVID-19 or were exposed to the virus would not be considered as organ donors.

### St. Augustine Bishop Estevez Calls for an End to Florida Death Penalty

All of Florida's death row inmates live in the Diocese of St. Augustine. Many are Catholic. At least twice a year St. Augustine's Bishop Felipe Estevez goes to visit death row inmates himself.

Bishop Estevez notes that no death row inmate in Florida has been granted clemency since 1983, and with 350 death row inmates, Florida has the largest active death row in the United States.

"We need to put a stop to the death penalty because, as John Paul II said, it is not necessary. We can put all our energy into having the best prison system so that these prisoners who are a danger to society will not do any harm to anybody."
