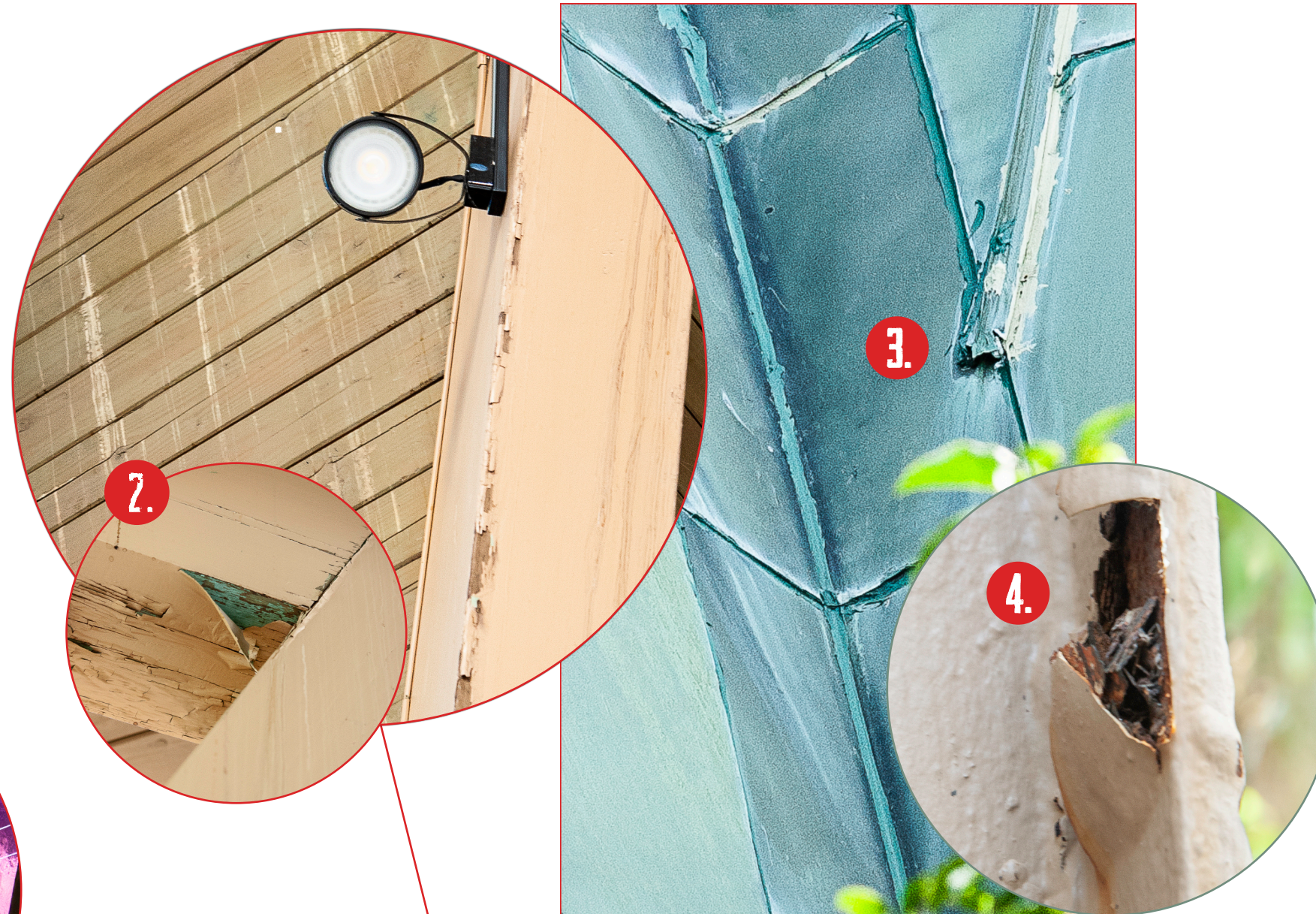

Phase 1 Scope of Work

Roof Replacement: The copper roof is original to the building built in 1959, and past its useful life cycle and needs to be replaced. The skylight directly above the altar shows signs of leakage also.

Stained-Glass: The stained-glass is a single paned glazing and not very energy efficient. Some of the stained-glass is cracked and portions of the metal framing are pulling away from the windows.

1. Cracked and missing pieces of stained-glass throughout the church interior need repair or replacement
2. Water damage to interior wooden ceiling and support beams
3. Although repaired and resealed over many years the copper roof continues to leak and needs replacement
4. The bell tower is structurally sound but has extensive corrosion and is in need of repair

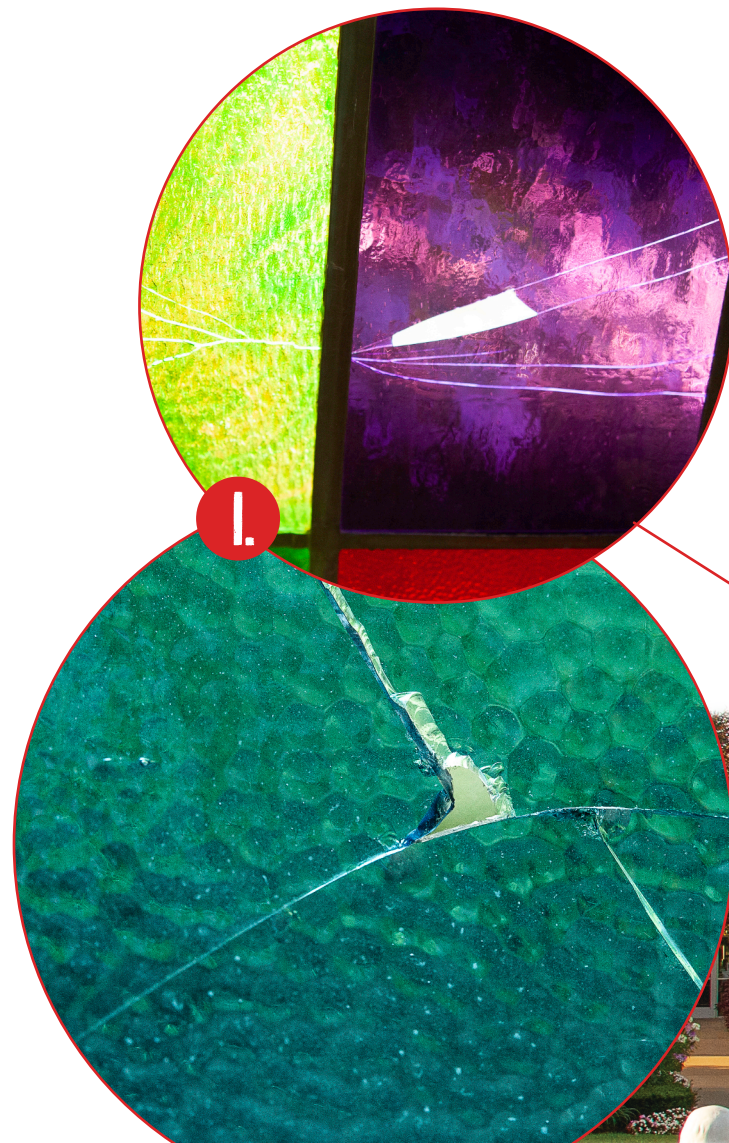


Phase 2 Scope of Work
